Study visit in Oslo: Compare Integration of Refugees - Establishing a European Platform for refugee teachers in vocational training

Timeframe: 19th to 23rd of June 2018

Participants: 12 refugee teachers/school masters in vocational training from Berlin

Background:

The Berlin Senate (SenBJF) initiated jointly with the OSZ LOTIS (a competence centre for vocational training) a study visit for refugee teachers and school masters in vocational training from Berlin in order to investigate into the integration of refugees in the european context and to share good practise examples (methods of teaching and offerings). The aim is to establish a European Platform for refugee teachers in vocational training.

1. The pilot study visit (funded by ERASMUS+) has taken place to Zwolle from the 19th – 22nd of June 2017 (10 participants from 5 different schools).
2. The return visit of the 25 colleagues from Zwolle is going to take place from the 22nd till 25th of April 2018 in Berlin.
3. The next study visits of other 12 refugee teachers and school masters in vocational training from different schools in Berlin is taking place at Naomi in Greece/ Thessaloniki from the 18th – 20th of October 2017.
4. The first working and exchange session in order to establish the good practise platform is taking place in Berlin the 29th of November 2017 for all former and future participants.
5. **Now we are planning the program for the study visit next year in Norway/Oslo from the 20th to the 22nd of June 2018 for another group of 12 people teaching in refugee classes.**
6. A conference “Wiko-International” is going to take place on the 29th of November 2017 in order to secure the learning outcomes and establish a European forum on refugee issues
